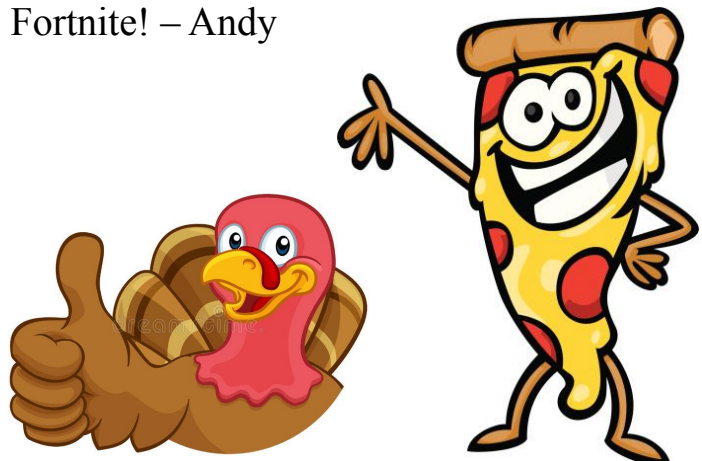
**Q: What do you do during Thanksgiving in college?**

**Q: Do you still go to classes if it's snowing? Do you get snow days in college?**

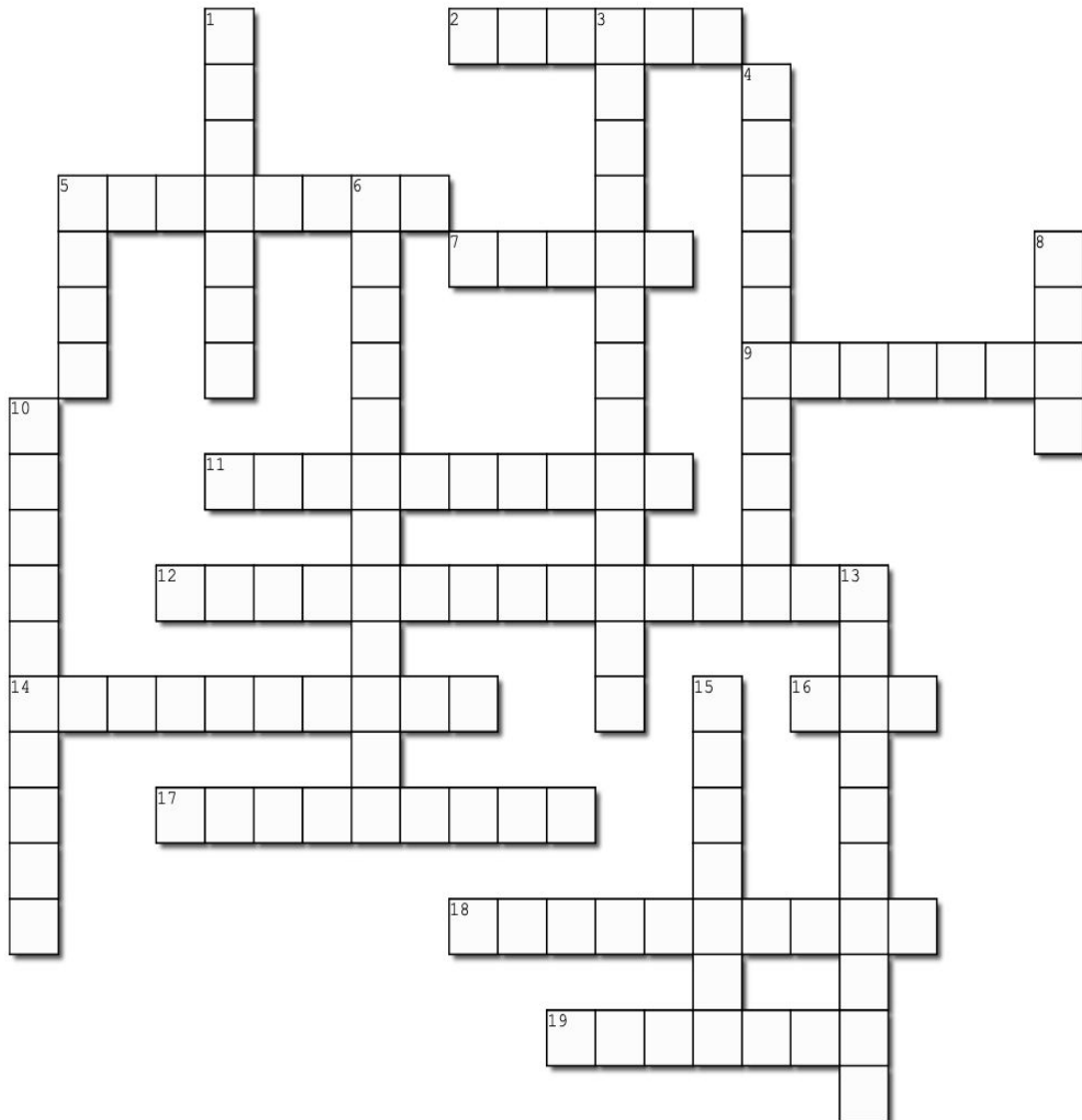

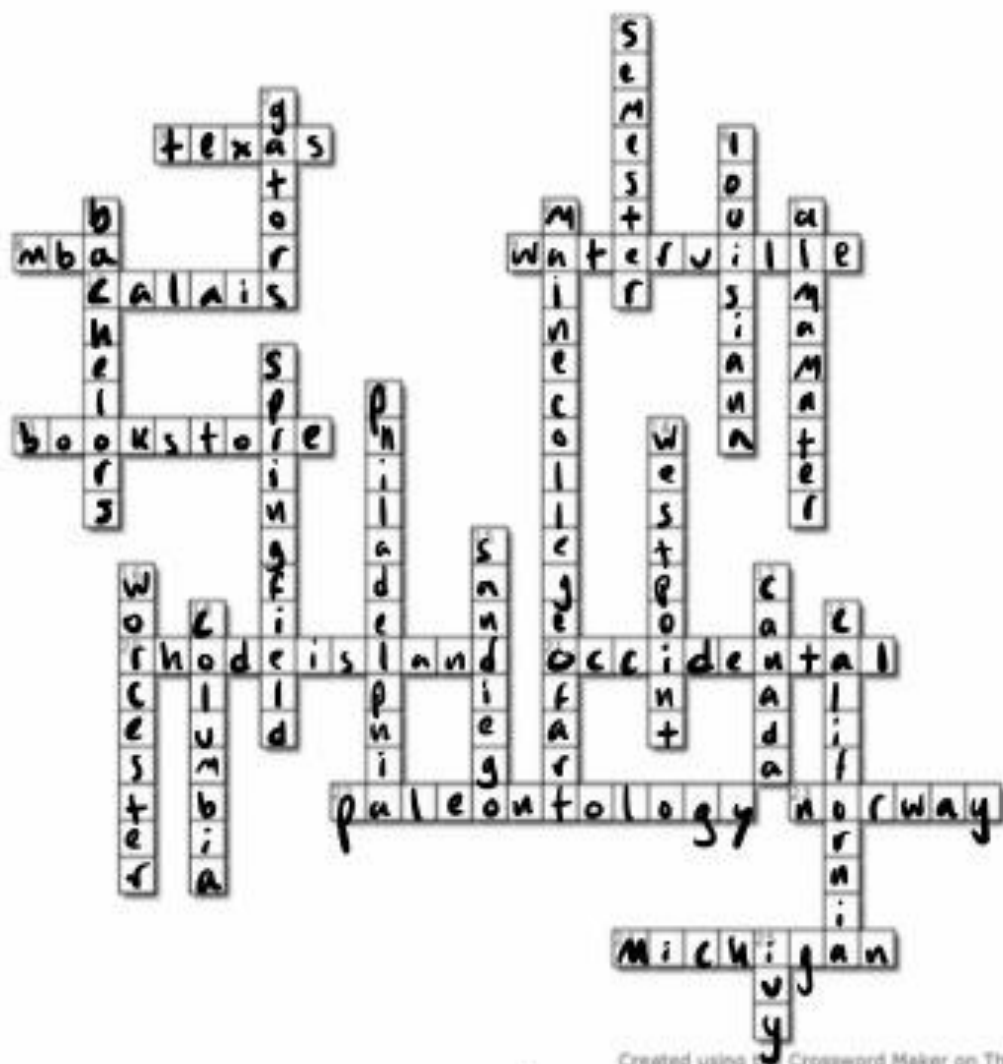
